Elver Park Neighborhood Center (EPNC) is hiring for its summer teen program. We are looking for an outgoing individual who can operate in a diverse neighborhood center. If you enjoy working with teens and fostering meaningful relationships with middles and high school students; we're looking for you!

Responsibilities: under the guidance of the EPNC Program Coordinator, the PASS AmeriCorps member will be responsible for direct supervision of teens, establish and maintain effective relationships with teens, plan and implement programming within the center. In addition, the PASS AmeriCorps member will implement and maintain center procedures for the safety of all participants while providing quality summer programming to teens.

Related Job Specifications: successful candidates must demonstrate the ability to work with urban youth, offer culturally relevant opportunities through lesson planning and in summer programming. Candidate should have experience in a collaborative, team-oriented environment and interpersonal skills that are respectful and inclusive.

Qualifications: candidates must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma. Direct experience working with diverse populations of teens.
