If you answered yes, become a Middle School U (MSU) instructor with Wisconsin Youth Company this summer! Be a part of a program designed for the growing independence of middle school students.

Position Summary: the MSU instructor plans and implements a recreational and educational week-long summer course for middle school age students in accordance with the policies and procedures established by Wisconsin Youth Company. Primary responsibilities of the position are to provide direct supervision to an assigned group of students, assure their safety and provide a quality, inclusive enrichment course designed to meet the developmental needs of each student. The instructor will have experience in group management, program organization and planning for middle school age youth. Instructors will be required to attend a brief informational meeting at the end of May or beginning of June.

Qualifications/Skills:

- Demonstrated level of expertise in a particular art, skill, hobby or recreation activity
- Seeking instructors with skills in STEM, digital media, crafting, cooking and gross motor activities
- Experience with middle school age students ages 11-14 preferred
- Two years towards a bachelor's degree related to the course, OR
- Related experience instructing in the course subject

Middle School U Instructor – LTE summer position, 15 to 30 hours of instruction per week-long course.

Compensation for full-day courses (30 hours/week) is \$340-530 per week

- Full-day courses are 9 a.m.-4 p.m., Monday through Friday
