Position Summary: The MSU instructor plans and implements a recreational and educational week-long summer course for middle school aged students. Primary responsibilities of the position are to provide direct supervision and instruction to an assigned group of students, assure their safety and provide a quality, inclusive enrichment course.

Course Information: Samples of courses include archery, rocketry, soap making, painting, photography, Lego robotics, gym sports, and many more. Each course is one week long and takes place from either 9 a.m.-12 p.m. or 1-4 p.m. Monday-Friday.

Qualifications/Skills:

- Demonstrated level of expertise in course specific topic
- Experience in group management and program planning for middle school aged students
- Experience with middle school age students ages 11-14 preferred
- Two years towards a bachelor's degree related to the course, OR
- Related experience instructing in the course subject

Middle School U Instructor: LTE summer position, 15 or 30 hours per week
Compensation for each half-day courses (15 hours/week) is \$190-285 per week
Compensation for two half-day courses (30 hours/week) is \$380-570 per week
Pay is based on education and related experience working with youth

- Half-day courses are offered from 9 a.m.-12 p.m. and 1-4 p.m., Monday through Friday
- Compensation is a set-rate including pre-program planning
