Position Summary: Upon direction from the site supervisor, the program leader supervises children in grades K-5 and implements fun, enrichment and educational programming for the students in their group. This person will also be responsible for following all health and safety standards as well as fostering positive relationships with campers, families, and the greater Elver Park community. This position includes working closely with community partners and co-workers on projects and events that serve the neighborhood and its families.

- Must be 18 years of age or older in accordance with Wisconsin state licensing requirement
- Able to supervise an active group of children and make decisions about their safety
- Ability to cultivate and maintain positive relationships with children, families, community partners, and others
- Direct experience working with diverse populations of school age children from various socioeconomic backgrounds
